CALL TO A CALLED MEETING OF THE PRESBYTERY OF NEW COVENANT for the purpose of approving the dismissal of Windwood Presbyterian Church to the Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians – Tuesday, May 19, 2015 at Noon

Dear Colleagues,

The Presbytery of New Covenant has been in litigation with the congregation of Windwood Presbyterian Church for many years. As a result of a court ordered mediation, their trustees have agreed to dismiss their lawsuit, and we have agreed to call a meeting of the presbytery for the purpose of voting on their dismissal from the PC(USA) to the Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians.

This is the only item of business on the docket for the meeting. We are calling the meeting for Noon on Tuesday, May 19, 2015, at John Knox Presbyterian Church (2525 Gessner, Houston, 77080). John Knox is located approximately 2 miles north of Interstate 10 (Katy Freeway), and one mile east of Beltway 8.

Commissioners are encouraged to bring a lunch to eat during the meeting, or to join together at one of the several restaurants near the church.

Prayer will be a main focus of our gathering, particularly for healing and reconciliation in our presbytery.

Registration will be onsite only. Commissioners can bring a completed form, or fill one out at the door. No preregistration is required. Quorum requirements are not less than three teaching elder members and the ruling elder members present, provided at least three churches are represented by ruling elders (under the By-Laws of the Presbytery of New Covenant).
