Dear Teaching Elder and Ruling Elder Commissioners,

The staff, session and congregation John Knox Presbyterian Church are honored to host the Called Meeting of the Presbytery on Tuesday, May 19, 2015, at noon. It is always a celebration when we gather with other disciples of Jesus, regardless of the purpose of the meeting, and we are excited about sharing this celebration with you all.

Registration for the brief meeting will begin at 11:30 a.m. A map with directions to the church is attached to this invitation, as is a floor plan of the church. The meeting will take place in the Fellowship Hall.

Reservations are necessary for those requesting childcare. Childcare will be provided for children who are five years old or younger. Childcare cannot be provided for children who are sick or require special care. Parents must provide a snacks, diapers, bottles, etc. Parents should pick up their children promptly after the Presbytery meeting. Please call the church office no later than one week prior to the meeting to indicate number and age of child/children for whom you are making reservations.

Parking is available on both the north and the south sides of the church, as well as on Brigade Street on the north side. Please allow those who have limited mobility to park on the north side or on the street, as it is closer to the meeting space.

Lunch will not be served at the meeting, but because we know Presbyterians love to eat, we encourage you to gather with fellow presbyters for lunch afterwards. There are several restaurants within easy walking distance and more within a mile or so. Juarez Mexican Restaurant is right across Brigade Street from the Fellowship Hall, and they are used to hosting large groups of Presbyterians! We also have a wonderful Vietnamese noodle house, Pho Saigon, in the same lot as Juarez. Alternatively, you may like to bring a lunch and enjoy a picnic under our beautiful oak trees.

The Presbytery Packet for this meeting will be posted online two weeks prior to the meeting, and mailed to those churches and ministers without e-mail. It is the responsibility of each commissioner and minister to access the packet and bring it to the meeting.
