To: Minister Members and Elder Commissioners to the Stated Meeting of the Presbytery of New Covenant

The Staff, Session and Congregation of the First Presbyterian Church of Conroe are delighted to host the Stated Meeting of the Presbytery on Saturday, March 19, 2016. Our congregation is always pleased to welcome visitors; and, we are especially happy to welcome our colleagues and friends from across the Presbytery.

Registration begins 30 minutes before the meeting opens. About 20 minutes before the meeting is Called to Order, there will be an orientation for new Commissioners in room 105.

The church is located at 2727 North Loop 336 West; which is across the street from an H-E-B grocery store. A map with directions to the church is attached to this invitation. When driving to the church, you will want to travel on Loop 336 instead of the other roads that may be suggested by your GPS.

Reservations are necessary for those requesting childcare for children who are five years and younger. Childcare cannot be provided for children who are sick or require special care. Parents must provide a sack lunch, snacks, diapers, bottles and other items as necessary. Parents should pick up their children promptly after the Presbytery meeting. Please call the church office no later than one week prior to the meeting to indicate number and age of child(ren) for whom you are making reservations.

Reservations for lunch are not required. Lunch tickets will be made available on a “first-come, first-served” basis. There are several restaurants close to the church; but, you don’t want to miss the meal that’s being prepared by the church’s Cooking Teams.

If you plan to travel on Friday and stay overnight in the area, you will find that there are several reasonably priced hotels in the Conroe. These include a Holiday Inn Express, and Hampton Inn and Suites. If you want to enjoy a bit more luxury, you may want to stay at the La Torretta Lake Resort & Spa in Montgomery.

Please let the Presbytery staff know of any equipment, meeting rooms, or display space desired. They will coordinate with us in making provisions. Please contact Lynn Hargrove to arrange display space at least one week prior to the meeting (lhargrove@pbyofnewcovenant.org). A floor plan of the church facility will be included with the Call to Meeting.

The packet for this meeting will be posted two weeks prior to the meeting on the Presbytery’s website (www.pbyofnewcovenant.org) and will be mailed to those churches and ministers without email. The Addendum will be posted no later than four days prior to the meeting. It is the responsibility of each Commissioner to access this information and to bring it to the meeting.

Directions to the First Presbyterian Church of Conroe:

From the South (Houston/I-45):

If you are traveling north on Interstate 45, take exit 84B in Conroe. You will then turn left (west) on Loop 336 and travel under the freeway. In 5.3 miles, the church will be on your right. Look for a white sign with blue lettering marking the entrance into the church's parking lot.

From the North (Huntsville/I-45):

If you are traveling south on Interstate 45, take exit 88 in Conroe. You will then turn right (west) on Loop 336. In 1.5 miles (just after Highway 105/W. Davis St.), the church will be on your left. Look for a white sign with blue lettering marking the entrance into the church's parking lot.

From the West (Montgomery/Highway 105):

Turn right on Loop 336 (immediately after the H-E-B grocery store). In only 0.2 miles, the church will be on your left. Look for a white sign with blue lettering marking the entrance into the church's parking lot.

From the East (Cleveland/Highway 105):

On the east side of Conroe, turn right onto Loop 336. You will follow the loop several miles around the north side of Conroe. About 1.5 miles after you cross over Interstate 45 (just after Highway 105/W. Davis St.), the church will be on your left. Look for a white sign with blue lettering marking the entrance into the church's parking lot.

It may look easier on your map, but you do not want to travel Highway 105 through Conroe to the church. Even though your GPS and your eyes will tell you differently, it is faster and easier to take North Loop 336 around Conroe than it is to take Highway 105 through town.
